Its history is bound up with myth and legend, but has never been forgotten. This talk also looks at the real Babylon, which has since been explored and excavated from the 19th Century.



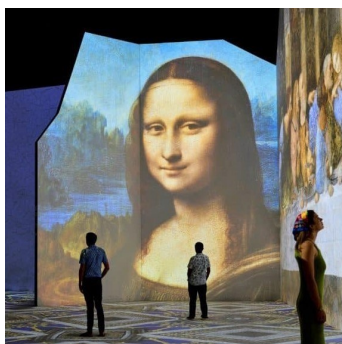
Monday 14 April 7pm
